

Mayor's Corner

↑ s I reviewed possible subjects for this month's Mayor's Corner, I was struck by the weather report. Yes, winter is here – the cold wind with cloudy skies and a snow forecast. Now February is here with perhaps more of the same to usher in the wind storms with possible tornados. A few years ago our police officer at the time, Thom Taylor, wrote an article on emergency planning for your home. After reviewing it, with a few minor changes, it reminded me to review our plans. So, for you, here it is.

There are many types of emergencies that would affect you and your family - both natural and man-made. The affect these emergencies have on you and your family members can be minimized by taking the time before an emergency arises to make an emergency plan. Every member of your home should be included in any planning and kept up to date on any changes. The emergency kit that i will be referring to is the same kit taken from the http://organizedhome.com/winter-preparedness-checklist website, with adjustments made for the time of year, weather and rotation of perishable items.

The most important part of this article is for you and your family to actually take the time to sit down, talk and make a plan.

#### Things to consider when formulating your family plan are:

Deciding to stay or evacuate Evacuation separation Finding a "safe area" in your home Communication/Information Pets Neighbors

The actual nature of the emergency will be a big part of your family's decision to stay in your home or evacuate. If you decide to evacuate, have a plan in place to gather all of your family members (including your pets!) and have some prearranged destinations. When planning your evacuation route, include alternate routes and alternate forms of transportation. Try to keep vehicles at a minimum of a half tank of gas at all times. Before you leave, contact neighbors to let them know of your decision to evacuate. If you have elderly or disabled neighbors

you may want to include them in your plan. Before you evacuate, turn off all utilities to your home. (Part of your planning should be to learn how to turn off all of the utilities.) If you are driving you should have your emergency to-go kit handy or in your car. Before and during travel, listen to any available news source to stay up to date on events and closures that might affect your evacuation.

Planning for emergency communication should include the portable radio and television and/or cell (smart) phone in your emergency kit. Use these to keep current with the status of the emergency by tuning to local and emergency stations that will be broadcasting regular updates. You should also plan for each member of your household to memorize, or have access to, the phone number of a designated out-of-town contact person. Local phone services will be very busy during an emergency and everyone calling the same contact person will help you to account for all family members.

#### For The Love Of Chervil

enjoy experimenting with different herbs and spices. Several years back I began using Fines herbes in my omelets, soups, sauces and stews. I loved the full flavor it provided and became curious as to what makes up Fines herbes. Used in French cooking, Fines herbes is typically compromised of a blend of parsley, tarragon, chervil and chives. Chervil? I had never heard of it! Through my research, I discovered Chervil (SHER-vuhl) was carried throughout Europe by the Romans where it is now naturalized. It is found in many French recipes including Béarnaise sauce and of course one of the main ingredients in Fines herbes. A member of the parsley family, Chervil is a delicate culinary herb which embodies its hosting food with very mild hints of aniseed.

I have not seen fresh Chervil in markets around the St. Louis area and dried is difficult to find in local grocery stores. I have found the best place to buy Chervil locally is at spice stores.





Though French recipes are the primary host for the use of Chervil, I truly enjoy its soft flavors in tomato based dishes and sauces. I flavor my chili, vegetable soup and a variety of sauces with dried Chervil. Below is a twist on an old family recipe which is simple, kid friendly and quick. I hope you take time to experiment with this versatile delicate herb and enjoy the sauce.

#### TWISTED MARINARA


- 2 14.5 oz. cans of diced tomatoes with garlic and onion
- 2 tsp. brown sugar
- 2 tsp. dried chervil
- ½ tsp. dried basil
- ¼ tsp. black pepper
- ½ cup sweet Marsala
- Salt to taste
- 2 tbsp. unsalted butter (optional: add for a richer flavor)

Combine the first five ingredients in a saucepan and bring to boil, turn to low heat and simmer five minutes. Add sweet Marsala and simmer an additional four minutes. Remove from heat and add the butter for a rich flavored sauce.

I serve this over pasta. Other serving ideas include serving over grilled chicken or sautéed shrimp or sliced smoked sausage links.
