

street blockage for emergency vehicles. The City will provide you with 'no parking' signs to avoid this parking situation.

For garage/estate sales, we ask that you get a permit from City Hall. Why? We will make sure the police are aware and we will provide the 'no parking' signs for the opposite side of the street. There is no charge for this service.



There are City ordinances dealing with weeds and/or grass, i.e. in a non-wooded area grass is not to exceed seven inches in height. Dead trees are the responsibility of the homeowner to be removed. Over the years, situations between neighbors concerning grass and dead trees between properties have developed. When necessary, the ordinance can be the decision maker. However, we encourage all citizens to talk to their neighbor now if you feel there is a problem developing. The same suggestion goes for any dog running loose. We have found more acceptable solutions for all when neighbors talk to each other.



DR. BIRD CAKE from the kitchen of holly mathis



am a pie baker. I have tried making cakes in the past, and for whatever reason, they generally are not a stunning success. They usually come out looking like tortes, frankly. So when my family wants a cake for birthdays, or special events, it's Dr. Bird time! This never-fail cake is basically a "quick" or soda bread, but made in a tube pan. It gets a nice, crispy flat top that can be decorated or not depending on your needs. I usually serve it just plain, but have thought that a cream cheese icing would make a good choice, similar to that used for carrot cake. But this cake is fabulous not iced, and since

it is not particularly "healthy," I usually just leave well enough alone. It freezes well, so if the thought of eating a huge cake between two of you at home puts you in a fright, iust cut into smaller sections and voila!

IN A LARGE MIXING BOWL COMBINE:

- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- 2 scant cups white sugar
- 1 tsp salt (I never use)

Mix dry ingredients together well.

WHISK TOGETHER:

- 1 cup veg oil
- 3 large eggs, slightly beaten
- 1 tsp vanilla

ADD TO DRY INGREDIENTS ALONG WITH:

- 3 diced ripe bananas.
- 8 oz. can crushed pineapple, with juice (that's the short can)

Stir by hand to mix, do not beat together, until just moistened.

Bake (non-convection) 350 degrees for 80 minutes in a very lightly greased tube or Bundt pan. Let cool completely in the pan (or as long as everybody will stand and wait for it). Loosen edges of cake from pan and remove from pan and enjoy!

The decaying wood tie walls were replaced with dyed concrete block walls.

The pool was outfitted with a new liner, coping and equipment.

By the time the project was complete, the only elements that remained from the existing yard were the beautiful pine trees that lined the east side of the pool area.

"We've always enjoyed our backyard, but now we are out there more than ever," says Mark. "The kids have gotten older, but they still love having their friends over to swim, barbecue and party. The puppies love chasing after the squirrels and chipmunks. And Rachel and I just like relaxing in our little oasis. Whether we are sipping coffee by the fire pit or enjoying a cocktail while taking in a ball game, it is truly our little slice of heaven."




