



e hear the expression "move on" frequently in today's society and most likely we have used it ourselves. And when we do it's generally an expression for "forget about a recent event and look forward." Today, I want to share with you an event that happened in May that can/will affect our moving on - one not to forget, but to build on.

Let's start with the City Council meeting of May 3. It was a really exciting event. The council recognized five outstanding 8th grade students from Crestview Middle School. It started with the students' health class teacher, Tammy Becker, assigning them to a drug and alcohol awareness project. Voila! She was so impressed with their work on this project that she began sharing it across our community - with the Rockwood Drug-Free Coalition, the Superintendent of the Rockwood School District, the City of Clarkson Valley, the Federal Drug Enforcement

Administration, and with many other folks who are interested in what we as a community can do to prevent drug and alcohol abuse among our kids. These students answered the challenge with a video entitled "Fatal Friendship". I urge you to see it at https://youtu.be/w4aEKNrd6oQ. This is powerful stuff - young people educating their peers as opposed to an older adult (like me) lecturing them. We know the problem of drug and alcohol abuse among our young people continues. Law enforcement is necessary - however, the trend continues. This video addresses prevention, yes, stop before it starts. That's the 'move on' path that can have positive results.

Also at the meeting, the Federal Drug Enforcement Administration presented each student with a Certificate of Advancement. The City has long supported the Rockwood Drug-free Coalition. With the leadership of Councilman Jim Meyer, we, with the Coalition, were the first City in West County to initiate a prescription take-back Drug Day. One more thing to remember before moving on: summer is a time of ball games, soccer, BBQs, vacations, swimming, events that shape our lives - just as Memorial Day (May 30th) and Independence Day (July 4th) have. Memorial Day is a day we remember and honor those men and women who died in service of our country. And July 4th is the celebration of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. The land of the free and the home of the brave is only true because of those we honor on Memorial Day. Yes, we 'move on' into summer, not forgetting the young people that make our future look so bright nor those who have gone before making the American dream still viable.


honey to buy two more additional bee-hives, thus helping to increase the population of pollinators!

A Refreshing Summer Side

Fresh tomato and peach salad is a great colorful side salad for family meals or an elegant dinner party. It is quick, easy and refreshing. The sweetness of the fresh peaches balances the acidity of the tomatoes providing a kaleidoscope of colors and textures. Add a rich cheese, fresh basil, and savory vinaigrette with hints of vanilla and you create summer in a bowl.

#### FRESH TOMATO AND PEACH SALAD WITH BAL-SAMIC VANILLA VINAIGRETTE

- 3 ripe firm peaches
- 3 large fresh ripe tomatoes (heirloom tomatoes can be used)
- 8 oz. burrata or fresh mozzarella (Ciliegine or Bocconcini), torn into pieces
- 6 basil leaves (thinly sliced)

Balsamic Vanilla Vinaigrette (recipe below)

Halve, pit and cut the peaches to desired shape - slice in wedges to serve on a platter or cut in chunks to serve in a large bowl. Remove core from stem end of large tomatoes. Slice into 1/2-inch rounds or cut in chunks to serve in a large bowl. Season the tomato and peaches with salt and pepper. Drizzle the balsamic vanilla vinaigrette over the top of the tomatoes and peaches then sprinkle with the cut fresh basil. Serve immediately.

NOTE: If making a salad bowl, drain cut tomatoes before adding anything else to the bowl to avoid excess liquid prior to tossing in vinaigrette.

#### **BALSAMIC VANILLA VINAIGRETTE**

- 1/4 cup white balsamic vinegar
- 3/4 cup virgin olive oil
- 1/2 vanilla bean, scraped
- 1 tbsp. honey (add more for additional sweetness)
- Pinch salt and fresh pepper

Whisk or shake in a jar to blend the above ingredients at least 30 minutes before serving. This can be made a day ahead and refrigerated up to 1 month. Bring to room temperature before serving.

Hint: Never store vanilla beans in refrigerator. Store in a tightly sealed container in a cool, dry, dark place away from heat such as a cabinet.

#### Additional Serving Suggestions:

If you want to elevate the flavors, try grilling the peach slices for a couple of minutes, cool and add to the salad. Add cooked fresh pasta to create a hearty salad.
