The closing date for filing is Tuesday, January 17, 2017.

A candidate for Alderperson must be a resident of the ward from which elected, at least twenty-one (21) years of age, a citizen of the United States and a resident of the city at the time of election for at least one (1) year preceding the election.







Joan was introduced to Kingdom House through her church, Manchester United Methodist. She attended a church seminar on poverty that was facilitated by Kingdom House President and CEO Scott Walker who spoke about the importance of serving people where they live.

Three months later, Joan and her son, Alex, volunteered at Kingdom House for a sort-a-shoe event. Eight-year-old Alex had a blast and was eager for another opportunity to help. She met a woman who was able to graduate from college because of the free childcare offered at Kingdom House; she is now a public-school teacher.

In addition to early childhood education, Kingdom House offers literacy-focused after school and summer camp programs. In response to low high school graduation rates and local teenagers' lack of job readiness, Kingdom Academy was created; a program which supports students with academic and life/job skills and pairs them with a Teen Advisor who helps them work towards high school graduation and post-secondary options.

Kingdom House offers robust programming for adults as well. Their innovative Financial Stability Services program includes one-on-one coaching, financial education and access to credit and wealth-building financial products. Other offerings for adults include English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) classes, Health & Wellness program, Wrap-Around Maternal Mental Health Services for Latina Mothers, and Social Capital Building.

Joan has become an advocate for Kingdom House. Thanks to her enthusiasm, interest in Kingdom House among her co-workers at the Bussmann Division of Eaton, located in Ellisville, has blossomed. She engaged her work team in a day of service by helping to set up Kingdom House's annual Backpacks & BBQ back-toschool event. She also coordinated her company's United Way Day of Caring. 



Holiday Frost Trifle

- 1 package (9 oz) gingerbread, pumpkin or spice cake mix or your favorite homemade cake
- 1 packages (3.9 oz) instant vanilla pudding mix
- 12 oz Cool Whip
- . 1 cup chopped walnuts, crushed ginger snaps, or pecans
- OPTIONAL: 1/4 tsp cinnamon, 1 TB orange liquor
- 1. Prepare and bake brownies or cake according to package directions for an 8-in. square baking pan. Cool on a wire rack. Prepare pudding according to package directions.
- 2. Mix Cool Whip topping into pudding. (add optional liquor or cinnamon to mixture).
- Cut or gently tear brownies or cake into 1-1/2-in. cubes. Place half of the cubes in a 3-qt. trifle bowl, martini glasses, small mason jars or large glass serving bowl; lightly press down to fill in gaps.
- Top with half of the whipped pudding mixture, nuts or ginger snaps; repeat layers.

- 1 package (9 oz) brownie mix or your favorite homemade brownies
- 1 packages (3.9 oz) instant chocolate pudding mix |
- 12 oz Cool Whip
- 1 package mini M&Ms or coarsely chopped chocolate Hershey's bar

Chocolate Ice Cream Sauce

- 1 jar marshmallow ice cream topping
- 1. Prepare and bake brownies or cake according to package directions for an 8-in. square baking pan. Cool on a wire rack. Prepare pudding according to package directions.
- 2. Mix Cool Whip topping into pudding. (add optional liquor or cinnamon to mixture).
- 3. Cut or gently tear brownies or cake into 1-1/2-in. cubes. Place half of the cubes in a 3-qt. trifle bowl, martini glasses, small mason jars or large glass serving bowl; lightly press down to fill in gaps. Top with half of the whipped pudding mixture, chocolate sauce, marshmallow topping and M&Ms; repeat layers.

For both recipes - Cover and refrigerate until serving. Approx 6-10 servings.

Before serving - Garnish with fresh red raspberries, chopped chocolate bar, crushed graham crackers, etc.

he rank of Eagle is the highest one L can achieve in the Boy Scouts of America. Approximately 6% of newly joined scouts go on to obtain this rank. Michael Robinson did so on June 1st, 2016.

Michael and his father Dale, his mother Mary, and his sisters Theresa and Emily moved to the St. Louis area from southern Texas in the summer of 2008. Being 10 at the time, he hoped to find an activity that would allow him to

establish himself in his new surroundings. The solution came in the form of scouting.

In the fall of 2008, Michael joined Cub Scout Pack 677 at his elementary school. Over the next year and a half, he would participate in a variety of activities, such as camping, the infamous Pinewood Derby, and Scouting for Food. In the winter of his fifth-grade year, Michael was old enough to move up to the Boy Scouts. Having obtained his Arrow of Light, the highest award in Cub Scouting, he crossed the symbolic bridge between Pack 677 and Troop 677 of Wildwood. With the support of his parents, and his father involved as an active member of the troop, he began his journey on the road to Eagle, a journey that would persist through the next six years of his life.

Troop 677 is a large troop, numbering approximately 100 scouts. As a result, the troop receives opportunities that smaller troops often do not. Michael was able to go to the Philmont Scout Ranch in 2013 and the Florida Sea Base two years later. In the past, he has served as Senior Patrol Leader, the youth leader of the troop.

To become an Eagle Scout, you first must obtain the previous five ranks, which necessitates knowledge of skills such as camping, cooking, and above all, leadership. Perhaps the most daunting of the tasks one must complete is the Eagle Project. This is the ultimate task of leadership development, as one must lead a group of fellow scouts and adults in a project that benefits an organization outside of scouting in a charitable way. For his project, Michael supervised the construction of a pergola to provide shade for an outdoor education center at the Wildwood YMCA.

The Scouting movement teaches its members essential life skills to aid them in their future. While some may think it only instructs children on how to tie knots and build fires, scouts also develop the ability to become leaders and respectable members of society.


