C larkson Valley resident Joan Bender is passionately committed to her volunteer work at Kingdom House - a social services agency ocated in St. Louis City. Founded in 1902, Kingdom House defines its mission as helping people achieve better ives. Through holistic programs and services, they assist the disadvantaged Manchester United Methodist. She attended a church semina on poverty that was facilitated by Kingdom House President and CEO Scott Walker who spoke about the importance of serving people where they live

Three months later, Joan and her son, Alex, volunteered at King dom House for a sort-a-shoe event. Eight-year-old Alex had a blast and was eager for another opportunity to help. The following year, they both volunteered at Kingdom House's Fall Festival. The event was transformative for Joan. She met a woman who was able to graduate from college because of the free childcare offered at Kingdom House; she is now a public-school teacher.

Kingdom House believes that education plays a pivotal role in helping people move out of poverty. In addition to early childhood education, Kingdom House offers literacy-focused after chool and summer camp programs. In response to low high school graduation rates and local teenagers' lack of job readiness, Kingdom Academy was created; a program which supports students with academic and life/job skills and pairs them with a Teen Advisor who helps them work towards hish school gradua tion and post-secondary options.

Kingdom House offers robust programming for adults as well. Their innovative Financial Stability Services program includes ne-on-one coaching financial education and access to credit nd wealth-building financial products. Other offerings for adults include Enslish for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) classes, Health \& Wellness program, Wrap-Around Maternal Mental Health Services for Latina Mothers, and Social Capital Building.

Joan has become an advocate for Kingdom House. Thanks to her enthusiasm, interest in Kingdom House among her co-workers at the Bussmann Division of Eaton, located in Ellisville, has blossomed. She engaged her work team in a day of service by helping to set up Kingdom House's annual Backpacks \& BBQ back-toshool event. She also coordinated her company's United Way Day of Caring. Her employer has been financially supportive as well, donating $\$ 1,000$ to Kingdom House through the company's employee-recommended corporate Eaton Cares program.

Joan encourages residents of the Clarkson Valley community to step out of their comfort zone to make a difference. One way to
do this is to do what Joan did - participate in Kingdom House's Urban Forum program. Urban Forum @ Kingdom House provides professional guidance in social justice education through immersive service learning. Kingdom House provides lodging in a home adjacent to their facility so that participants can truly immerse themselves in the community for the duration of their stay

Lastly, Joan recommends getting your kids involved in voluntee ing with you, which can have a huge impact on their lives, helping them grow into caring and community-oriented adults.

## Holiday Frost Trifle

1 package ( 9 oz) gingerbread, pumpkin or spice cake mix or your favorite homemade cake
1 packages ( 3.9 oz ) instant vanilla pudding mix
12 oz Cool Whip
1 cup chopped walnuts, crushed ginger snaps, or pecans OPTIONAL: $1 / 4$ tsp cinnamon, 1 TB orange liquor

Prepare and bake brownies or cake according to package directions for an 8 -in. square baking pan. Cool on a wire rack. Prepare pudding according to package directions.
