City l'axes!



July spells Summer. And for your City it's the beginning of a new fiscal year. The City's fiscal year is July 1-June 30. The 2018-19 budget was approved at our regular June council meeting. (Side Bar) We have a committee developing a new Web site for possible launch next month. The new budget will be included, watch for it. Any time

you talk about a government budget, it's about taxes and how they are spent. So, I thought a review of the taxes you pay your City and why would be appropriate. What taxes do you pay directly to Clarkson Valley. They are: real estate, personal property tax, tax on electric usage and cable service. These are standard taxes paid by St. Louis County residents. How do we compare to other cities in West County? After all, Clarkson Valley owns nothing, i.e. no streets to repair, no buildings to maintain, etc. So what about those taxes you pay that are directed to the city? How do they compare to other cities' rates; what does the city provide you, the citizen; and are they doing so with efficiency?

Taxes

The total tax rate used to determine your tax bill is composed of many governmental entities; Rockwood School District, fire district, metropolitan zoo, county services, etc. and Clarkson Valley. The residential real estate rate for Clarkson Valley is \$0.125 per \$100.00 assessed valuation. For a home assessed at \$500,000.00 located in Clarkson Valley, the tax would be \$118.75 while the same assessed value home in Chesterfield would be a \$57.00 - difference of \$61.75 a year. Clarkson Valley provides trash pickup at no charge to the residents - but more on that later

As you can see, the amount of tax dollars paid within each city differs greatly. This is as it should be. Chesterfield and the other municipalities shown above have streets, buildings, maintenance requirements to meet, etc. So your total is and should be less.

Watch for next month's article. I will include a brief history of Clarkson Valley and detail how ordinances are in place to meet the City's three primary responsibilities. With the passage of the county Prop P tax, we will receive an estimated \$120,000 for public safety. We are reviewing the parameters for public safety to make it happen. The amount obviously is tentative as there is no history. This will mean a separate set of books to track these dollars. Looking at revenue and expenses without Prop P, our estimates are: revenues \$935,000; expenses \$927,330 - a revenue plus of \$7,670. This fiscal year 2018-19 looks positive; however, with more variables around Prop P money than in any previous years, we will continue to be vigilant.



Did You Know?

- The Liberty Bell sounded from the tower of Independence Hall on July 8, 1776, summoning citizens to gather for the first public reading of the Declaration of Independence by Colonel John Nixon.
- June 14, 1777, the Continental Congress, looking to promote national pride and unity, adopted the national flag. "Resolved: that the flag of the United States be thirteen stripes, alternate red and white; that the union be thirteen stars, white in a blue field, representing a new constellation."
- The word 'patriotism' comes from the Latin patria, which means 'homeland' or 'fatherland.
- The 56 signers of the Declaration of Independence did not sign at the same time, nor did they sign on July 4, 1776. The official event occurred on August 2, 1776, when 50 men signed it.
- The first public Fourth of July event at the White House occurred in 1804.
- Both Thomas Jefferson and John Adams died on Independence Day, July 4, 1826.



ROAD-TRIPPING THE EMERALD ISLE

Road trips are all about adventure: exploring the unknown, freedom to go wherever you choose, spontaneous experiences that a loosely-planned itinerary allows... For me, there's nothing better than unexplored country, a good map, and a windy road - Adventure awaits around every corner.

Speaking of road trips, I recently completed a three-week selfdrive tour of Ireland. Some friends were getting married just out side Dublin, which presented a unique opportunity to explore a country that had long been at the top of my 'To Visit' list. Having



survived my first Irish Wedding, I rented a car, threw my bag in the back, and set out.

Immediately, I found Ireland to be one of the best places in the world for road-tripping. First of all, the country is STUNNING! Its beautiful countryside with shades of green like you've never seen, rugged coastline, with towering cliffs and pounding surf, swirling clouds with serious 'Light Drama'. A road trip in Ireland is a feast for the eyes.

Secondly, the people are AMAZING! The Irish are some of the friendliest (and funniest) people on the planet. They're welcoming, always up for a laugh, always interested in what brings you to their corner of the Emerald Isle. It's easy to find a pub, order a pint, strike up a conversation, and learn all you could ever want to know about the locals and the surrounding area. You're sure to have a good laugh, and more often than not, you'll find yourself invited to whatever happens to be going on in town. Ireland has a way of landing visitors right smack in the middle of the 'craic'.

Third, Ireland is SMALL. In total area, it's smaller than Indiana (33K square miles to Indiana's 36K). There aren't any long-haul drives to get to 'the next stop' -- it's not geographically possible. Drive more than five hours in any one direction, and you're likely to end up in the ocean. In Ireland, 'the next stop' is no more than an hour or two down the road, with plenty of sights to see and things to do in between. Medieval towns, crumbling castles, historical landmarks. They're sprinkled throughout the country. Add these to every little town that has its own Irish charm, and you've got more than enough to fill up an itinerary of any duration.

My trip began with a cross-country drive from Dublin to Donegal ('cross-country' being just over three hours), where I hiked the impressive Slieve League - at almost 2,000 feet, these towering cliffs rise three times higher than the more-famous Cliffs of Moher (both highly recommended). After this, I drove along the northern Causeway Coastal Route, stopping to visit to the Giant's Causeway, and headed south for a night in Belfast and a visit to the Titanic Museum. Then it was back to Dublin for a night, and cross-country

again to Lahinch and those famous Cliffs of Moher. The next day entailed a spectacular dive through the Connemara and a night in Galway. Then I drove south to the tiny fishing village of Dingle and circled the Dingle Peninsula. After that, it was on to Killarney and a blustery day around the Ring of Kerry. Cork and the Blarney Castle, the Rock of Cashel, Kilkenny and Kilkenny Castle ... the list goes and on and on ... Needless to say, it was an INCREDIBLE trip!




