



## mayor's corner This Month, We Welcome A Guest Writer:

CHESTERFIELD POLICE SERGEANT CHRIS CONNELLY



Clarkson Valley residents may soon notice a new piece of equipment attached to their neighborhood officer's uniform. Although it appears as a small black plastic square attached to the center of the officers uniform shirt, it is actually among the latest innovations in law enforcement technology. Known as "Body Cameras," these devices record official communication between officers and

those with whom they come into contact. These cameras afford our officers with considerable protection while simultaneously capturing vital information for use in ongoing investigations.

Each officer has been issued their own device for which they are individually responsible. Prior to receiving the cameras, officers attended in-service training where they received instruction on the proper use of the cameras. It is important to note that officers are bound by department directives which outline when, where and under what circumstances the body cameras are to be used. Body cameras are not designed to capture cordial conversation, but are

expected to preserve the interactions of officers with violators, witnesses and the like. Body cameras are manually activated by the officer wearing the device. Once activated, the camera will capture the incident in real time and will also preserve all actions during the thirty seconds prior to activation.

At the conclusion of the officer's tour of duty, the body camera is loaded into a docking station. All of the data captured on the camera is then uploaded to a "Cloud" for storage. At that point, video captures are secure and may only be retrieved by officers and supervisors to confirm information relative to an investigation. Body cameras provide supervisors with a tool that allows them to conduct regularly scheduled audits in an attempt to verify that vital safety practices are being adhered to. In addition, should allegations of misconduct be made, supervisors will review body camera data as a part of those supervisory inquiries.

Nationally, body cameras have received strong accolades from various sectors. Clarkson Valley Officers will be utilizing the body cameras at no cost for one year. After l years' time has passed, a review of the program will be conducted. Should the results of the review

> prove favorable, the cameras will be purchased and the program will continue.

In a related matter, law enforcement officials in Clarkson Valley will soon be asking residents with existing

video surveillance to voluntarily register with the police department. Law enforcement is seeking to develop a database of residents who have external surveillance systems. The focus of this "Community Camera Program" is to identify those residents who may have captured vital video evidence, recorded either during or immediately following any criminal activity that may occur.

Many communities have experienced successful prosecutions as a result of this program, and we expect no less in Clarkson Valley. More information soon on how you can register.

Mom and dad say I'm extremely spoiled, but I don't know what that means. They say that I'm part of the family. This means me feel special.



Now, my husband will tell you that I'm no mathematician, but I do know my 1, 2, 3s about PIE. There are cream pies, fruit pies, ice cream pies, pizza pies...the delicious list is endless!

*My family especially loves the juicy, sweet taste of a peach pie* made with Eckert's peaches. The first pie I made was straight out of my momma's "go to" cookbook. Every time I made another, I tweaked the ingredients until I reached this delectable recipe! A scoop of vanilla ice cream completes it.

Summer, and peaches, please hurry and get here!



#### PIE CRUST PASTRY RECIPE

• 1 teaspoon salt

• 2 cups all-purpose flour

- <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup shortening, butter, or lard
- 5-6 tablespoon very cold water

Stir flour and salt in medium bowl. Cut in shortening until it resembles pebbles. Sprinkle water, 1 tablespoon at a time, until all flour is moist and almost comes clean from the side of the bowl. Divide into 2 balls. Chill for 30 minutes.

#### MOMMA'S OLD-FASHIONED PEACH PIE RECIPE

- Pie crust pastry for two-crust pie
- 6 cups peeled sliced peaches (about 11 medium)
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/3 cup flour
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> teaspoon cinnamon
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> teaspoon vanilla
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> teaspoon almond extract
- 2 tablespoons butter, cut into small pieces
- Cinnamon/sugar mixture for garnish

Heat oven to 425. Prepare pastry. Roll ½ of pastry onto a floured surface 2 inches larger than the pie pan. You should still see little pieces of the butter, shortening or lard in the crust. Fold pastry into quarters, unfold and ease into pan.

Mix peaches, vanilla, almond extract and lemon juice. Stir together flour, sugar, and cinnamon; mix with peaches. Turn into the pastry-lined pie pan. Dot with butter.

Cover with top crust. You can cut strips and make a lattice crust or cover with a crust and cut slits in it. Crimp edges using thumb and first finger of one hand and first finger of other. Sprinkle with cinnamon sugar mixture. Cover edge with a 2-inch strip of aluminum foil to prevent uneven browning. Remove foil the last 15 minutes of baking.

Bake 40-45 minutes until crust is light brown and juice begins to bubble through the slits.

Author's Notes: To make peeling peaches easier boil a large pot of water. Cut a notch in one end of the peach. Drop peach into the water for 30 seconds then shock in ice water. Use a paring knife to peel the skin. Allow the pie to cool completely so that it has time to set up and will not be runny.

**Author's Secret:** Sometimes there isn't time to make pie crust. If you buy the refrigerator roll out crust no one will know but you and me. The filling will be so yummy it won't matter!






