My husband William and I have lived in Forest Hills since 1969. They all swam before they could walk thanks to Debbie's Swimming School and the DCCA, so naturally, that meant joining the swim team when they were just 4 years old. Not one of them failed to place in a swim meet for 10 years.

I've always loved being super involved in my children's lives. When Susan was 7 years old, I organized the Forest Hills Junior







Tennis Program. Once we found a tennis pro, he took over that position. Bill and I also served on the F.H. Swim Committee for over ten years, and I continued to work with the Junior Golfers for another 20 years.

Our family was always very busy. Susan played golf her first year at St. Joseph Academy while Shannon and Christine played field hockey and soccer for Villa Duchesne. On the weekends, our family also enjoyed riding horses at our farm in St. Clair, MO. We each had our own horses as well as several extra for company. When the girls went to college, we sold the farm and bought

a place at the Lake of the Ozarks for boating and fishing. Our grandchildren have loved it just as much as Bill and I do.

In the 90s, I began serving the Women's Board of Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital, which kept me busy until Bill said, "As long as you're working, why not get a paying job?" So, I did! I had attended the Academy of the Sacred Heart in St. Charles and graduated from Maryville University, and I was anxious to teach and share my love of learning. I got a job teaching at the Little Flower Catholic School in Richmond Heights for five years while I also got my master's in the Teaching/Learning Process from Washington University. I also started a winning track team for grades 1st-8th.

I then began teaching at Holy Infant Elementary in Ballwin, closer to home. The next year, I was invited to teach at a new school called Gateway Academy on Wildhorse Creek Road. Leaving after only a year was hard, but we decided to winter in Florida.

When we started wintering in Florida, I began teaching ESL English as a second language upon request from the students at Lorenzo Walker Institute, Collier County's Jr. College, in Naples, FL. I had been a missionary in Honduras, CA, in the Summer of 1962 and in New Mexico in 1964, so I knew I loved working with my Spanishspeaking children of God. They were so anxious to learn.

When we returned to Clarkson Valley, I continued to volunteer at Rockwood in their Adult Literacy Program. I got very involved with the Mexican families at the Chesterfield Trailer Court and began teaching the adults at night and the children during the day. Beginning this coming December 12th, The Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Ascension will be having a bi-lingual Mass at 12:15 every Sunday for everyone. The mass will be celebrated in English and Spanish.


As of late, I have been writing and rewriting a short book about the pioneer sister of the Religious of the Sacred Heart who had come from France to teach the American Indians, frontier children, and children of slaves about God's love and mercy.

We used to go to Church at St. Joseph's in Manchester, but now we celebrate Mass closer to home at St. Clair of Assisi, St. Anselms, and Ascension. I took on the job of leading "The Clarions," a fellowship group for people over 55-years-old, who meet once a month at St. Clair of Assisi to enjoy one another's company and venture out to the community together. We meet on the first Tuesday of the month from 9-11pm for coffee and donuts, oftentimes with a guest speaker or activity.

I only have wonderful memories of this area and consider myself very blessed to have had such amazing life experiences. Bill and I especially love walking the golf course right before sunset, and our home at #1 Greenbank allows for just that.




