MEET THE SERFAS FAMILY

The roof represents Row, Sally's father who provided the lion's share of caregiving for his wife. The foundation of the house represents Gearldean, Sally's mother whose legacy remains as the 'foundation' of their multi-generation family. The defining decision on the name of Assistance Home Care was the fact that the founder's initials are the 1st three letters in Assistance (A - Allen, S -Sally, S - Serfas...coincidence?)

Allen graduated with a degree in Finance from the University of Iowa. Allen enjoyed a 20+ year career and executive management experience as Corporate Officer with Enterprise Rent-A-Car. Allen thrived in Enterprise's entrepreneurial and customer service-focused environment helping expand new territories along

with pioneering the company's Truck Rental Division. Allen's commitment to customer service, exceeding customer's expectations and his commitment to employee development were key ingredients to his success at Enterprise. These key ingredients are at the heart of the foundation of what drives Assistance Home Care. Allen is actively involved with his wife in supporting the Alzheimer's Association, APDA, Memory Care Home Solutions, Aging Ahead and numerous other local organizations helping to provide advocacy and support for the St. Louis senior care community. Most recently, Allen sits as the President of the Foundation Board for Aging Ahead, Board of Directors for the Alzheimer's Association as well as was recently appointed by Governor Parsons as a member of the Missouri Alzheimer's State Plan Task Force.

Sally graduated with a B.A. Degree in Education from Lindenwood University. As a family caregiver herself, Sally knows that the best way to give people exactly what they want is to listen to their needs. She has spent a lifetime listening, planning and problem-solving for her parents while nurturing her community as an

elementary teacher before settling into being a full-time mom. After her mother's diagnosis of Alzheimer's, Sally spent years as a caregiver to her mother, who ultimately lost her fight in early 2011. Sally's deep participation with her parents and in the human condition along with an understanding of what families can go through led her to co-found Assistance Home Care in her mother's honor and build a truly caring and compassionate community of caregivers.

Assistance Home Care helps honor one's wishes to stay at home and age in place. Their team of Caregivers or 'Care Pros' as they call them assist their clients with things like mobility support, personal care like bathing and dressing, exercises, meal prep support, medication reminders and other household support tasks. They specialize in memory and mobility care at home. This means that the majority of their clients are impacted by memory loss, Parkinson's, stroke, MS, or ALS. However, they can assist any older adult or senior who just needs extra support at home. Another unique aspect of their team is that they are able to provide same-day assessments or 'Discovery Visits' as they call them.





These visits are 100% complimentary and can be done at a primary residence, hospital, rehab facility, or even at one of their local offices! Their team does not believe in the dreaded two-to-three weeklong 'wait lists' to start home care as other providers may have, in factmany of their clients can begin services within 1-2 DAYS of their initial call!

Assistance Home Care recommends starting the difficult and awkward conversations early! Understanding one's wishes, whether it's that they wish to age in place at home or they wish to age in a community, can help families tremendously in honoring their loved ones' wishes! They often meet with families whose loved one's care needs have snowballed so quickly that the conversations don't happen, and the family just doesn't know or understand how to best serve and support their loved ones' wishes.

Assistance Home Care's 'Why' behind their business comes from cofounder Sally's Mother whom she lost to Alzheimer's disease. They encourage their clients to take advantage of this program early, especially when dementia is part of the equation so that families can capture memories and share them for generations to come.

But their unique team has a specialized focus on seniors and older adults with full-time care needs as well as hiring skilled fulltime Care Pros on their team. O ummer is in full swing. Summer camp, vacations, and the Fourth of July! Nothing beats a delicious, Savory rack of ribs with all the trimmings. Here is a great recipe to spice up your backyard BBQ. And you probably have most of the ingredients in your spice cabinet. Rub the mixture into the ribs and cook them low and slow. Finish with your favorite BBQ sauce and settle in for the fireworks. Enjoy a great time with family and friends. God Bless America!

RIB RUB

- 1/2 Cup Brown Sugar
- 2 Tablespoons Paprika (Smoked, Sweet or Mixed to Taste)
- 1 Tablespoon Black Pepper
- 1 Tablespoon Kosher Salt
- 1 Tablespoon chili powder
- 1 tablespoon Garlic Powder
- 1 tablespoon onion powder
- 1/2 Teaspoon Cayenne Pepper
- 1/2 Teaspoon Ground Mustard
- 1/2 Teaspoon Cumin

1. Mix all ingredients together. Pat the ribs dry on both sides. Remove the membrane from the bone side. It will make for a more tender cut of meat. Drizzle a tiny bit of oil on the ribs; just enough to help the rub adhere to them. 2. Sprinkle 3-4 tablespoons of rub mixture on one side and rub it into the meat. Turn over and repeat. Line a large piece or two (to fit) of foil with parchment paper.




