

RIGHT PLACE, RIGHT TIME!

Clarkson Valley School Resource Officer Andrew Budd saves Crestview Middle School student's life.

he City of Clarkson Valley is fortunate to have full-time School Resource Officers in our Middle & High Schools. We have had the benefit of these Chesterfield Police Officers patrolling Marquette High and Crestview Middle for years. Most days are routine while the officers provide high visibility to promote a safe & secure learning environment. However, Friday, May 12, 2023, turned out to be anything but routine for School Resource Officer Andrew Budd as he patrolled the corridors of Crestview Middle School. As the noon hour neared, Officer Budd directed his attention to the cafeteria to ensure order throughout the lunch periods. At approximately 12:46 PM, Budd observed a student stand from a seated position. The student was clearly in

distress. The manner in which the student was grabbing at his throat caused Budd to believe that the student

He quickly made his way to the student through the crowded cafeteria and saw an Assistant Principal approach the student and attempt to administer the Heimlich Maneuver. However, the abdominal thrusts delivered by the principal failed to clear the airway. Officer Budd arrived and quickly determined that this was in fact, life-threatening and that the student was experiencing a total airway obstruction. The student's color had become ashen. Acting in response to his training, Budd administered four abdominal thrusts. After the fourth thrust, the object became dislodged and was expelled. At that point, the

student took a deep breath and his breathing and color immediately returned to normal. Once Officer Budd confirmed that the student could again breathe without difficulty, he escorted the student to the nurse's office for further medical evaluation. Officer Budd's actions in this instance were clearly heroic and truly saved the life of another.

In my late teen years, I worked as a lifeguard and had the opportunity to assist with several water rescues. The affirmation that one experiences from contributing to the saving of a human life lasts a lifetime. So often these days, police officers receive unjust criticism, and we hear such phrases as,"They're never around when you need them!" Well, in this case, Officer Budd was absolutely in the right place

at the absolute right time to make a lifelong, significant impact in the life of another person.

The next time you have the opportunity to be in the presence of a law enforcement officer, I would encourage you to speak to the officer and express your gratitude for their willingness to serve on all our behalf. I assure you that your gratitude will go a long way toward affirming the officer's decision of many years to commit himself/herself to public service.

Jack loves cheering on the STL City team and his favorite, Seattle Seahawks. He hopes to eventually play sports in high school, like his older brothers.












QUESTIONS PAPA ASKED GRAY:


What do you want to be when you grow up and why? I want to be a Video Game Maker or a Scuba Diver.


