Dad learned rudimentary Spanish for our trip to Mexico and we

drove all the way down through Mexico to Guatemala. We watched the cliff divers in Acapulco and walked up the Pyramids of the Sun and Moon. We went to places I probably wouldn't recommend now but we met wonderful people in Mexico City and saw beautiful places off the beaten path in Mexico that most tourists never get to experience.

Our camping vacations ended at Kentucky Lake when we woke to a horrendous thunder and windstorm. Dad made us all run out to hold down the tent poles to keep the tent from blowing away. The next morning, we discovered a tornado had just missed us. At that point, my Mom put her foot down: "NO MORE TENTS!"

Looking back, these are great memories; they provided real adventures and great answers to "What did you do on vacation?" We made countless wrong turns but saw something we wouldn't have seen if we hadn't. It taught me that it's never too late to explore new pathways and embrace the way life's trip evolves. 




































Not all companies trim trees the same way. There are a few small, but important things that Ballwin Tree Service does to make a big difference.

- They don't use spikes while trimming trees Spikes are worn on the outside of a climber's boots to help him climb the tree. They can make climbing easier, and they are acceptable to use when removing a tree, but when trimming a tree, they can damage the tree and promote the spread of disease. 


How did you meet my grandmother? It was grade school when some of us went


What's your favorite part of having grandchildren? Just being with them and how excited they are to be with us... Hope that never changes!




